#### Happy New Year

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We would like to wish all our playgroup families and children a very happy new year. We are really looking forward to another year at playgroup. We are excited to be welcoming lots of new families and children to playgroup this month and again after Easter 🐵

#### Planning

This half term we will be learning all about 'How we travel'.

To begin with the children will listen to the story 'All change'. They will explore shapes and make shape trains. We will explore moving like trains in a follow the leader style game. The children will use their mathematical skills to sort items according to colour, weight, using trains and carriages.

We will then explore transport that travels through the air. The children will make paper aeroplanes and we will measure how far they go when we throw them. The children will make various different craft throughout the week. The children will explore different countries that we can get to on planes and by air.

We will then learn about different farm machines. The children will mark make outside using tyres and paint. We will also make tyre prints with gloop inside. The children will use diggers to sort. We will also sing farm songs.

We will then be listening to the story Mr Bumpy's boat ride. We will act out the story. The children will explore items that sink and float. We will take part in a travel survey. The children will tell us how

they got to playgroup that day. We will count the results. We will use Musical instruments to sing songs.
