Looking forward to the rest of this half term


Next week we will read the story 'Little Sunflower'. We will learn about the life cycle of a sunflower and what plants need to help them grow. The children will use their physical skills to plant their sunflowers, and use mathematical language - 2 scoops of soil, 1 seed. How tall will it grow? We will investigate the life cycles on the iPad and watch the growth of a sunflower. Also, this week the children will use musical instruments to explore different sounds and sing songs.

We will then be reading the story '**Paper Dolls**'. The children will talk about emotions and feelings and play games, such as pass the emotion, in a group. The children will use their physical skills to cut paper dolls and use mark making skills to draw on them. The children will

make up their own rhymes and songs. We will talk to children about memories and things we remember. We will draw pictures of their favourite memories. We will also play memory games with different objects.

We will then read the story 'The Dot'. The children will take part in lots of free choice mark making activities. We will encourage the children to experiment with mark making and use their imaginations to talk about what they have drawn. Drawing in lots of different ways and challenging the children to add to their marks. Drawing around objects and exploring size.

The last story we will be reading this half term is 'My Body has a Bubble'. The children will learn about personal space and people that are special to them. The children will make bubble wands out of pipe cleaners and create large bubbles around ourselves.

Alternately please send in a labelled bottle of sun cream which we will use for your child.
