### In this months newsletter

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### Our learning this half term

To begin our learning children will share their news from the Christmas break. We will start to learn our new topic - **Space and Science**. We will learn about the night sky and learn about stars. We will look at star shapes and make shooting star wands.

***The children will listen to the story 'how to catch a star'***

Then, we will explore different shapes and make shape rockets. The children will look at their names and older children will make name rockets by sticking the correct amount of shapes to match their sounds in their names.

***The children will listen to the story 'whatever next'***

We will then be moving on to learn about the different planets in the solar system. We will talk about the size of the planets and take part in size ordering activities.

We will learn about the planet we live on and what it looks like from space.

The children will take part in astronaut craft.

*Towards the end of the month the children will learn about the moon. The children will use the iPad with adult supervision to research the moon. They will look at people landing on the moon and take part in experiments about gravity. We will make and play with moon dough.*

The children will use foil to create moon paintings.

The children will take part in movement activities, fast and slow. What it's like to move in space.

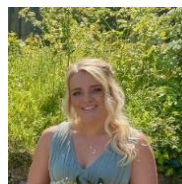

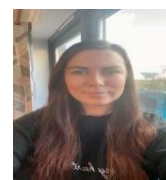

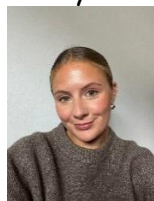
