I cannot believe we are now in our final half term of this acedmeic year! This half term our Topic is 'Summer Time'.

This half term we will plant seeds to watch grow. We will learn about what seeds need to grow. The children will learn where our different foods come from. Outside the children will make patterns from flowers using sticky frames. We will use our senses to explore different herbs in the tuff spot outside.

We will then move on to explore mini beasts. We will take part in mini beast hunts. The children will help to make a wormery. At the craft table we will use bubble wrap to create patterns and make bee hives. We will learn how bees make honey. We will listen to the story "Super Worm". The children will make tally charts of how many bugs they find.

We will also be making fathers day cards and medals out of clay, for our mini sports day.

REMINDERS

Suitable clothing, footwear, sun cream and sun hats

During the summer months please can children bring in a named sunhat.

Children can either bring in their own labelled sun cream to leave at playgroup, or for a £1 contribution they can use playgroups'. If you would like to use playgroups' please either bring in £1 or BACS it over. We do ask that children have sun cream applied before attending their sessions, and we will reapply throughout the day if needed.

We advise that sun cream used is a factor 50 and has a five-star UVA Rating.

Please can we request that thin strapped dresses/tops are not worn (shoulders covered where possible).

Please ensure that children wear summer shoes that have a secure back (not flip flops). and that are the correct size for your child's feet.

Lunch Boxes

Grapes, cherry tomatoes, large blueberries and sausages should all be cut in half sideways. We also ask that children do not bring frubes in their lunch boxes, as children often attempt to open these themselves and often spill on their clothing.

Library books

A reminder for children to use our playgroup library system, bring their book back in their book bag and they can choose a new book to take home.
