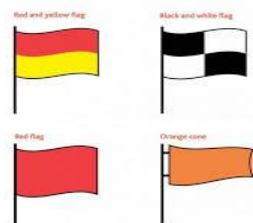

We have some Exciting News

What are we learning about this half term.....



To begin our half term will celebrate farming fortnight. The children will learn about different animals that live on farms. We will play guessing games, describing different farm animals. This week we will also make paper plate rock pool craft to celebrate World ocean day. We will learn about different size sea creatures. We will then move on to learn about the equipment farmers use to produce food. We will sing farm songs.

We will then be looking at the country where we live to celebrate the start of world cup. The children will make England flags using a variety of different craft techniques throughout the week. Outside we will practice our physical ball skills. The children will use musical instruments to sing songs.

Towards the end of the month we will learn all about the beach and sun safety. The children will learn how to stay safe on the beach, what the different colour flags mean and how to be safe in the sun. We will make beach flags and beach craft. We will incorporate math skills in the sand pit with building big/small sand castles and counting them. We will play listening games in the environment.

Each week we will have a sign of the week, number of the week and book of the week.

Our Learning intentions this half term

Communication and language

- Use a wide range of vocabulary
- Enjoys listening to longer stories and can remember what happens
- Understand how to listen and why listening is important
- Starts to say how they are feeling uses words and actions

Physical development

- Use large and small motor skills to do things independently.
- Develop manipulation and control.
- Start to take part in group activities which they make up themselves or in teams.

Personal, social and emotional development

- Feel strong enough to express a range of emotions
- Talk about their feelings in a more elaborated way.

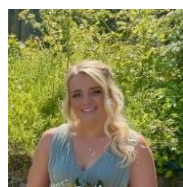

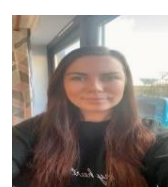
