<u>Suitable clothing</u>

Footwear

Please ensure that children wear suitable footwear to playgroup that they can be active in. We do ask that children do not wear wellies as a shoe all day. With hopefully the sunnier weather approaching, we ask that children wear footwear with a supportive back (not flip flops).

Sun cream and sun hats

During the summer months please can children bring in a named sunhat, for the hotter months. Children can either bring in their own labelled sun cream to leave at playgroup, or for a ± 1 contribution, they can use playgroups'. If you would like to use playgroups' please either bring in ± 1 or BACS it over. We do ask that children have sun cream applied before attending their sessions, and we will reapply throughout the day if needed.
