This half term we are leaning all about...... Growth, spring, and our emotions

We have enjoyed the first couple of weeks back at playgroup since the Easter Break.

Next week the children will explore and learn about mini beasts. We will go to the school woods and use our own outdoor space to go on mini beast hunts. The children will have mini beast surveys to tick off and learn the names of the mini beasts. We will make mini beast crafts and look at different patterns of mini beasts and take part in counting activities, counting spots, stripes, number of legs and wings ect.

This week the children will listen to the story 'Jack and the beanstalk'. We will plant our own bean plants and talk about what the plants need to grow. We will experiment with growing the beans in different conditions and compare how they grow. We will measure our own heights and compare sizes. We will take part in imaginative stories about growth
